

*Despite what anyone may tell you, parking fees are waived.

Many people were told there would be a parking fee by the person who took their reservation. When the regular hotel reservation is busy, calls are forwarded to a "reservation service". The reservation service is not privy to what's in our contract, and the hotels GM told me she has no way of communicating contractual changes to this agency. So, ignore any mention of parking fees.

*Wednesday wasn't part of the initial convention contract and I'll take ownership for that. I didn't expect so many people planning on coming in on Wednesday. Wednesday has been included in the group rate, so that will be reflected in your reservation.

*I've been told that some people who are planning on coming in early had to make three reservations, based on how many days they were coming in for. I've been told that those reservations have since been consolidated into one.

*Someone contacted me that they were informed of a \$20/day service fee on their room. It's actually a 20% pre-authorization on the card you used to make your reservation, in case anyone racks up a bar or restaurant bill.

*As of Thursday October 14, 2021, there are approximately 50 rooms still available at the host hotel. When those are gone, there's a small Econolodge about two blocks from the host hotel that has blocked 20 rooms (all non-smoking).

Additional rooms are available for those that would want a smoking room.

Additionally, there are five hotels just outside the city limits with rooms blocked. They're all less than a 10 minute drive, which is all highway, that drops you off a few blocks from the host hotel.

The parking lots are much bigger at those hotels if you're looking for a place to park a bike-hauling trailer. We will be providing shuttle service to and from all five of these hotels, starting Thursday or Friday (based on demand).

*There are three camping areas included on the registration form. Two with hookups and one strictly tent primitive.
